



Thanksgiving is a little different for all of us this year, isn't it? You are either going to miss that family gathering you were looking forward to, or you are gathering with family and just praying no one gets sick, or you may be frustrated at everyone else for worrying about getting sick! Whatever situation you are in, chances are you didn't expect this kind of Thanksgiving. This year may require extra effort to give thanks during Thanksgiving. Are you up for it?

"Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us be thankful, and so worship God acceptably with reverence and awe, for our 'God is a consuming fire.'" Hebrews 12:28-29

"Enter His gates with thanksgiving and His courts with praise; give thanks to Him and praise His name. For the Lord is good and His love endures forever; His faithfulness continues through all generations." Psalm 100:4-5

"Through Jesus, therefore, let us continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise — the fruit of lips that openly profess His name. And do not forget to do good and to share with others, for with such sacrifices God is pleased." Hebrews 13:15-16

Here are three practical ways to practice gratitude:

<u>The Greater Middle East Blessing</u> (use captions by clicking on CC), <u>The Blessing Nigeria</u>, <u>The UK Blessing</u>, <u>The Blessing (Global Choir)</u>, and <u>more!</u>

When it seems like we are surrounded by division, this kind of unity is healing to our souls, isn't it? Do you think God might be doing something powerful in the Body of Christ if He is bringing different churches and even nations together to sing His praise?

3. Try making a list of all you are thankful for, starting with the small things like hearing the geese honking as they fly overhead. Watch your perspective change as you see each item you write down as a gift from God just for you today.
